



2026 Camp Counselor in Training (CIT) Volunteer Positions Available

The Arethusa Farm Camp is an outdoor, hands-on summer day camp held at the working farm at Arethusa Farm Foundation, 14 Webster Road, in Litchfield, CT. The camp runs for 10 weeks, with a total capacity each week at 75 campers. The camp will maintain a staff to camper ratio of 1 staff to 10 campers.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 14 years old as of June 1, 2026
- Must submit two references during the application process.
- Since Arethusa Farm Foundation is an established 501c3 non-profit organization, volunteer employment at the Farm Camp as a counselor in training (CIT) qualifies for earning SAE (Supervised Agricultural Experience) hours for area regional agriscience program work experience requirements.

Expectations:

- Volunteer counselors in training (CIT) must have transportation and report to the farm each workday at 8 am and remain at the farm until 4 pm.
- All staff are expected to interact in an enthusiastic manner with campers and other staff.
- Since the camp is held at a 140 acre working farm, all staff are expected to be able to actively participate in all camp activities while supervising the campers, including physical activities, games, and long walks between areas on the farm property.
- All staff are expected to act in a professional manner and follow staff instructions.
- Counselors in training (CIT) are expected to work full weeks (all five days) for any camp session they are interested in working for continuity purposes.
